

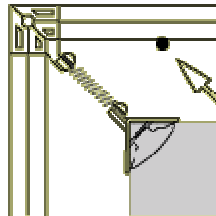
AFIX Wall displays & fixtures



1. Nailed to the wall

Mount frames on the wall easily and inexpensively with the nails supplied, ideally nailed through the corner holes, or anywhere along the extrusion if need be. The light weight of the AFIX frames ensures a simple, easy and long lasting installation

- Available with profile(s): Square or octagonal, round (Rondofix), rectangular (Ecofix)
- Tips: Hammer the nails in and let them sink in 15 mm. A level tool will help you perfect the installation. Position the frame. As shown in the sketch, place as convenient.



2. Mounted with self-adhesive

Mount frames on the wall in a non-permanent way (frames can be stuck several times over)

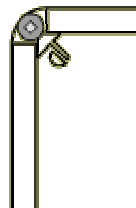
- Available with profiles: Rectangular only (Ecofix)
- Tips: Glue 2 or 4 blocks on the back of the frame, then remove the clear protection at back. Place on wall. It can be repositioned several times by removing it carefully from the wall.



3. Screwed in wall and mounted with spacers

Install frames on the wall permanently and fashionably by screwing through the holes in the four corners. By using our 25 mm aluminium spacers, you'll pop away from the wall. As a result, your displays will seem to be floating in the air and can be changed very easily.

- Available with profile(s): Square or octagonal, round (Rondofix), rectangular (Ecofix)
- Tips: Place your frame on the wall, then with help from a level tool and a pencil, mark the holes position. With a screwdriver, delicately screw the frame through the holes in the plastic corners and onto the spacers. Use of pegs is optional, but it will make the display sturdier.



4. Now on slat walls!
